


SuniTAFE VCE & VPC Outcomes 2023

SuniTAFE provides Senior Secondary school programs across the region for students who wish to complete a Victorian Certificate of Education (VCE) or a Victorian Pathways Certificate (VPC). We are committed to providing quality programs to re-engage individuals who may not have completed schooling within a school setting. SuniTAFE offers a link with other Vocational Education and Training as part of these programs. Each year SuniTAFE monitors and analyses data related to VCE and VPC student participation, completion and outcomes.

The graph indicates destinations for VCE and VPC students who completed in 2023. This data is a clear indication of SuniTAFE's commitment to improving student foundation skills and increasing options for further study and employment.

SuniTAFE values the feedback of students on their level of satisfaction with the program and outcomes. SuniTAFE aims for each student to feel they are being engaged in the course throughout the year and are provided with support to plan for future study and employment options.

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SuniTAFE VCE & VPC Outcomes 2023

During the year students are required to attend progress interviews. These meetings provide feedback and planning opportunities for students, parents and teachers.

In addition to these feedback methods, students are also requested to complete a satisfaction survey annually as detailed below:

1. 2023 Annual Student Satisfaction Survey results:

Victorian Certificate of Education

- 49.3% of respondents felt effectively supported throughout the learning
- 49.3% of respondents felt they were stimulated during the learning
- 49.3% of respondents felt there were adequate training resources through the learning
- 50.1% of respondents were satisfied with the trainer quality throughout the learning
- 49.3% of respondents reported there were clear expectations throughout the learning
- 49.3% of respondents were satisfied overall with the VCE course
- 53.6% of respondents were satisfied with effectiveness of Assessment
- 43% of respondents were satisfied with relevance of training
- 51.5% of respondents were satisfied with competency development
- 48.9% of respondents were satisfied with active learning

A total of 7 VCE students completed the 2023 Student Satisfaction Survey and no responses were received from VPC students.

2023 Completions – Destinations:

- The programs offered by SuniTAFE in 2023 changed from VCAL to VCE and VPC.
- SuniTAFE had a decrease in the number of enrolments during 2023. There was a total of 39 enrolments in 2022, compared to 24 in 2023.
- There was a decrease in the number of completions compared to 2022. In 2022 38% of students completed their VCAL level, compared to 21% completing the courses in 2023.
- There was an increase in the number of students who continued further study at SuniTAFE, with 35.9% in 2022, compared to 42% in 2023.
- There was an increase in the number of students who gained employment, with 23% gaining employment in 2022 compared to 32% in 2023.
- There was an increase in the number of students who entered further study with other RTOs, with 2.5 % in 2022, compared to 5% in 2023.

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
