


## SUNITARE SuniTAFE VCE & VPC Outcomes 2024

SuniTAFE provides Senior Secondary school programs across the region for students who wish to complete a Victorian Certificate of Education (VCE) or a Victorian Pathways Certificate (VPC). We are committed to providing quality programs to re-engage individuals who may not have completed schooling within a school setting. SuniTAFE offers a link with other Vocational Education and Training as part of these programs. Each year SuniTAFE monitors and analyses data related to VCE and VPC student participation, completion and outcomes.

The graph indicates destinations for VCE and VPC students who completed in 2024. This data is a clear indication of SuniTAFE's commitment to improving student foundation skills and increasing options for further study and employment.

# SUNITARE SuniTAFE VCE & VPC Outcomes 2024

In addition to these feedback methods, students are also requested to complete a satisfaction survey annually as detailed below:

### 1. 2024 Annual Student Satisfaction Survey results:

SuniTAFE conduct an annual student satisfaction survey, this survey includes students from the VCE and VPC courses. In 2024 there was a very low number of VCE and VPC students who participated in the survey therefore the results were not analysed in detail at course level. SuniTAFE will commit to working with the relevant staff to improve the response rate within the VCE and VPC courses in 2025.

### 2024 Completions - Destinations:

- There was a significant increase in the number of students we were unable to obtain destination data for, due to being uncontactable. This is reflected with 39% being unknown in 2024 compared to 11% in 2023.
- SuniTAFE had an increase in the number of enrolments during 2024. There was a total of 31 enrolments in 2024, compared to 24 in 2023.
- There was a decrease in the number of students who continued further study, with 36% in 2024 compared to 42% in 2023.
- There was a decrease in the number of students who gained employment, with 13% in 2024 compared to 32% in 2023. This decrease could be due to the increase in unknown destination data.
- There was an increase in the number of students who gained a traineeship, with 5% in 2023 compared to 6% in 2024.
