

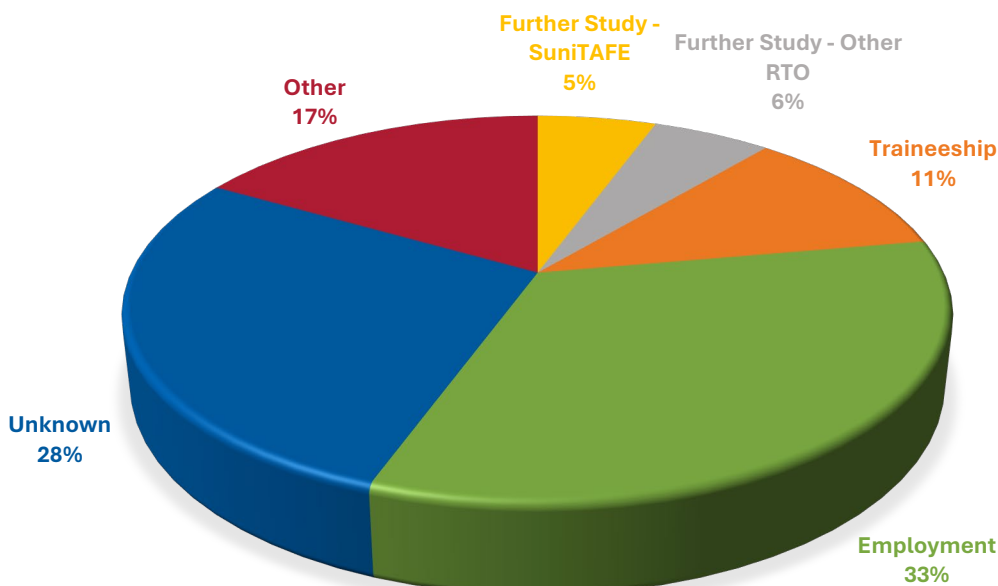
Victorian Certificate of Education (VCE) and Victorian Pathways Certificate (VPC) Outcomes 2025

SuniTAFE delivers Senior Secondary programs across the region for students seeking to complete the Victorian Certificate of Education (VCE) or Victorian Pathways Certificate (VPC). These programs are designed to re-engage learners who have not completed their schooling in a traditional school setting, with integrated delivery of Vocational Education and Training.

SuniTAFE is committed to the provision of high-quality programs that support students to build foundation skills and transition to further education, training or employment. To support this, the Institute undertakes annual monitoring and analysis of VCE and VPC student participation, completion and post-study outcomes.

The graph below presents the destinations of students who completed VCE and VPC in 2025, demonstrating the effectiveness of these programs in supporting further study and employment pathways.

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Student Satisfaction

SuniTAFE places a strong emphasis on student feedback to inform program quality and outcomes. The Institute aims to ensure students remain engaged throughout their course and are supported to plan pathways into further study and employment.

Students participate in scheduled progress interviews during the year, providing structured opportunities for feedback and forward planning between students, parents/carers and teaching staff. In addition, all students are invited to complete an annual satisfaction survey.

1. 2025 Annual Student Satisfaction Survey Results

SuniTAFE conducts an annual student satisfaction survey, incorporating students enrolled in VCE and VPC programs. In 2025, responses were received from the full VCE and VPC cohort.

The Overall Learner Satisfaction score was 74.5. The highest scoring category was Overall Satisfaction (88.4), while Active Learning recorded the lowest score (71.3). The highest rated question was *“I would recommend the training to others”* (92.2), whereas *“I looked for my own resources to help me learn”* recorded the lowest score (62.9).

2. 2025 Completions – Destinations

- The proportion of students with unknown destinations decreased to 29% in 2025, compared to 39% in 2024, reflecting improved mechanisms for follow-up and data capture.
- The proportion of students gaining employment increased significantly to 35% in 2025, compared to 13% in 2024.
- The proportion of students progressing to further study decreased to 12% in 2025, compared to 36% in 2024.
- The proportion of students commencing traineeships increased from 6% in 2024 to 12% in 2025.

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
