


# **SuniTAFE VCAL Outcomes 2022**

SuniTAFE provides Senior Secondary school programs across the region for students who wish to complete a Victorian Certificate of Applied Learning (VCAL). We are committed to providing excellent programs to re-engage individuals who may not have completed schooling within a school setting. SuniTAFE offers a link with other Vocational Education and Training as part of VCAL programs. Each year SuniTAFE monitors and analyses data related to VCAL student participation, completion and outcomes.

The graph indicates destinations for VCAL students who completed in 2022. This data is a clear indication of SuniTAFE's commitment to VCAL and improving student foundation skills and increasing options for further study and employment.

SuniTAFE values the feedback of VCAL students on their level of satisfaction with the program and outcomes. SuniTAFE aims for each student to feel they are being engaged in the course throughout the year and are provided with support to plan for future study and employment options.

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# **SuniTAFE VCAL Outcomes 2022**

During the year students are required to attend progress interviews. These meetings provide feedback and planning opportunities for students, parents and teachers.

In addition to these feedback methods, students also complete a satisfaction survey annually as detailed below:

### 1. 2022 Annual Student Satisfaction Survey results:

### Victorian Certificate of Applied Learning - Foundation

- 92.6% of respondents felt effectively supported throughout the learning
- 81.6% of respondents felt they were stimulated during the learning
- 89% of respondents felt there were adequate training resources through the learning
- 89% of respondents were satisfied with the trainer quality throughout the learning
- 92.6% of respondents reported there were clear expectations throughout the learning
- 85.3% of respondents were satisfied overall with the VCAL Foundation course
- 89% of respondents were satisfied with effectiveness of Assessment
- 85.3% of respondents were satisfied with relevance of training
- 84.6% of respondents were satisfied with competency development
- 89% of respondents were satisfied with active learning

## Victorian Certificate of Applied Learning – Intermediate

- 74.5% of respondents felt effectively supported throughout the learning
- 80.1% of respondents felt they were stimulated during the learning
- 76.8% of respondents felt there were adequate training resources through the learning
- 76% of respondents were satisfied with the trainer quality throughout the learning
- 70.1% of respondents reported there were clear expectations throughout the learning
- 79.1% of respondents were satisfied overall with the VCAL Intermediate course
- 81% of respondents were satisfied with effectiveness of Assessment
- 80.1% of respondents were satisfied with relevance of training
- 74.8% of respondents were satisfied with competency development
- 70.1% of respondents were satisfied with active learning

### **Victorian Certificate of Applied Learning – Senior**

- 84.6% of respondents felt effectively supported throughout the learning
- 91.2% of respondents felt they were stimulated during the learning
- 86.8% of respondents felt there were adequate training resources through the learning
- 85.1% of respondents were satisfied with the trainer quality throughout the learning
- 82.4% of respondents reported there were clear expectations throughout the learning
- 89.0% of respondents were satisfied overall with the VCAL Senior course
- 81.8% of respondents were satisfied with effectiveness of Assessment
- 83.5% of respondents were satisfied with relevance of training

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# **SuniTAFE VCAL Outcomes 2022**

- 85.4% of respondents were satisfied with competency development
- 80.2% of respondents were satisfied with active learning.

A total of 18 VCAL students completed the 2022 Student Satisfaction Survey. This sample consisted of 3 students from foundation level, 10 students from intermediate level and 5 students from senior level.

Of the entire sample, 84.4% of respondents were satisfied overall with their VCAL course and this was the highest scoring Quality Indicator. Followed by 84.3% of respondents reporting they were satisfied with the learning stimulation throughout the learning. The lowest scoring Quality Indicator for this sample size was the satisfaction with active learning which scored 79.7% across all levels of VCAL.

### 2. 2022 VCAL Completions – Destinations:

- SuniTAFE had a decrease in the number of VCAL enrolments during 2022. There was a total of 39 enrolments in 2022, compared to 68 in 2021.
- There was a decrease in the number of completions compared to last year. In 2021 38% of students completed their VCAL level, compared to 36% in 2022.
- The number of completions in VCAL Senior level increased by 49% compared to 2021 whilst both VCAL Foundation decreased by 40% and Intermediate level decreased by 2%.
- The VCAL Senior level had the highest number of student completions (78%) whilst VCAL Foundation level had the lowest number of student completions (7%).
- There was an increase in the number of students who entered a traineeship, with 15.38% entering a traineeship in 2022, compared to 10.29% in 2021.
- In 2022, 35.90% of students reported that they were currently engaged in further education at SuniTAFE, compared to 48.53% of students in 2021. This shows a 12.63% decrease.

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
